SANDY FULTON APPOINTED CHIEF OPERATING OFFICER

International Forest Products Limited (“Interfor” or the “Company”) (TSX: IFP.A) announced today that its Board of Directors had confirmed the appointment of Sandy Fulton as Senior Vice President and Chief Operating Officer, effective immediately.

Sandy joined Interfor in September 2004 as Senior Vice President, U.S. Operations following the purchase of the Crown Pacific mills in Washington and Oregon. In 2005, Sandy’s responsibilities were extended to include the Adams Lake and Queensboro operations along with the balance of the Company’s North American structural products marketing activities. In 2006, Sandy assumed responsibility for all of the Company’s manufacturing and marketing efforts, including cedar and offshore activities.

Sandy is an experienced senior executive having served as Executive Vice-President, Operations of Crown Pacific Inc. and as President and C.E.O. of Pacific Forest Products Limited.

His appointment as C.O.O. recognizes his strong contribution to the Company’s progress in the last two and a half years, and sets the stage for further growth in the years ahead.

Interfor is one of the Pacific Northwest’s largest producers of quality wood products, with a combined annual capacity of 1.3 billion board feet. The Company’s operations are located in British Columbia, Washington and Oregon, including three sawmills in the Coastal region of British Columbia, one in the B.C. Interior, one in Washington and two in Oregon. In addition, Interfor operates value-added remanufacturing and specialty products facilities in B.C. and Washington.
