Interfor is committed to implementing and achieving the Sustainable Forestry Initiative® (SFI®) Fiber Sourcing Standard (2015-2019 Edition) as part of its wood procurement program to broaden the practice of sustainable forestry. This policy is communicated throughout the organization and our partners in the forestry community.

Interfor promotes scientifically, environmentally, socially and economically sustainable forestry practices to meet the needs of the present without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their needs. This is accomplished by promoting a land stewardship ethic that integrates reforestation, growing, and harvesting of trees for useful products with the conservation of soil, air and water quality, biological diversity, wildlife and aquatic habitat, recreation and aesthetics.

Interfor is committed to comply with applicable federal, state and local laws and regulations, including social and labor laws, and takes appropriate steps to comply. This includes the implementation of State water quality Best Management Practices. It also promotes forest certification with family forest owners and requires contract loggers and wood producers to participate in appropriate logger training programs and be considered Qualified Logging Professionals.

To implement and achieve the SFI Fiber Sourcing Standard, Interfor has developed and adopted programs and plans to guide its wood procurement activities. These programs and plans are contained in appropriate documents including the SFI Evidence Manual, the SFI Fiber Sourcing Program and Annual Management Review.

The company is committed to annually review the effectiveness of its Sustainable Forestry Policy, Programs, and Systems and to continually improve its sustainable forestry program.
